

SUB: AWARD OF STIPEND

Applications in the prescribed format are invited for the award of stipend for the academic session 2020-2021, and Entrance/Merit of Admission 2021, as per the following guidelines:

1. Fifty percent concession (half freeship) on tuition fee shall be admissible to 5% of the total students in a class, belonging to the economically weaker section, whose parents'/guardians' income from all sources does not exceed Rs.1,50,000/- p.a. The students concerned shall be required to submit income certificate (of current / relevant period) issued by the Tehsildar/SDM/ competent authority, along with the application form. If the given information is found to be false, or suppression of facts is detected at any stage, then the student shall deposit back all the stipend received and further action will be taken as per ISTC Rules/ provision of law.
2. Fifty percent concession on tuition fee shall be admissible to 5% of the students, on Merit basis, admitted in every academic year of every course. The fee concession for students of batch 2021 (1st year) will be on the basis of their rank in the Entrance Examination/Merit of Admission 2021 of ISTC held in 2021. The fee concession for students of batch 2020 (2nd year) will be purely on the basis of their combined ranks in the first year; for batch 2019 (3rd year), it will be purely on the basis of their combined ranks in the second year; and for batch 2018 (4th year), it will be purely on the basis of their combined ranks in the third year, (both semesters taken together).
3. In case a student is eligible for both the kinds of stipend as given in (1) and (2) above, he/she shall be considered for merit based stipend only. The eligibility as per economic criteria will be considered thereafter.

The stipend as available at (1), and (2) above shall be given subject to the following conditions:-

- (d) The students shall be entitled for the stipend provided they clear all the exams of the entitled year in the first attempt and have not been punished for any misconduct.
- (e) For 'Means' based stipend, if the no. of eligible students exceeds the limit of 5%, priority shall be fixed on merit basis.
- (f) For merit based freeship, if anyone within first 5% is found ineligible, the benefit of freeship shall not extend to next candidate.

As such, the no. of students eligible for stipend /concession (as given at 1 & 2 above) shall be as per the following table:

Imp: Students receiving any scholarship /financial assistance from any other source, during the period of claim shall not be eligible for the above stipend.
